



EC Declaration of Conformity

REACH EC 1907/2006 Registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemical substances

Herewith we inform you about the latest update on the REACH regulations.

The EC Regulation No 1907/2006 – REACH, covering the registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction of chemical substances entered into force on June 2007 with the purpose of protecting human health and environment.

The European Chemicals Agency ECHA has published an initial Candidate List of “Substances of Very High Concerns” or SVHC on October 2008 and has since then updated the list every 6 months. The latest update includes 191 substances.

Neutrik confirms that the articles we put on the market do not contain one of these substances above a maximum concentration of 0.1% by weight in the articles, other than the items mentioned below.

- opticalcon NKO2M-A* and NKO2S-A*
contains in amounts potentially greater than 0.1% the substance
2-(2H-benzotriazol-2-yl)-4,6-ditertpentylphenol (UV-328), CAS 25973-55-1
As this substance is not intended to be released into the environment under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, there are no known safe handling instructions.
- copper products like XLR, plugs and jacks as well speakon and powercon comprising copper alloys such as brass contain the substance lead greater than 0.1% (CAS 7439-92-1, EC No. 231-100-4)


Regarding substances listed in annex XIV and XVII of EC 1907/2006 Neutrik confirms that articles comply to this regulation.

This declaration is based on our current knowledge and experience. Once new information is available an update will be made accordingly.
